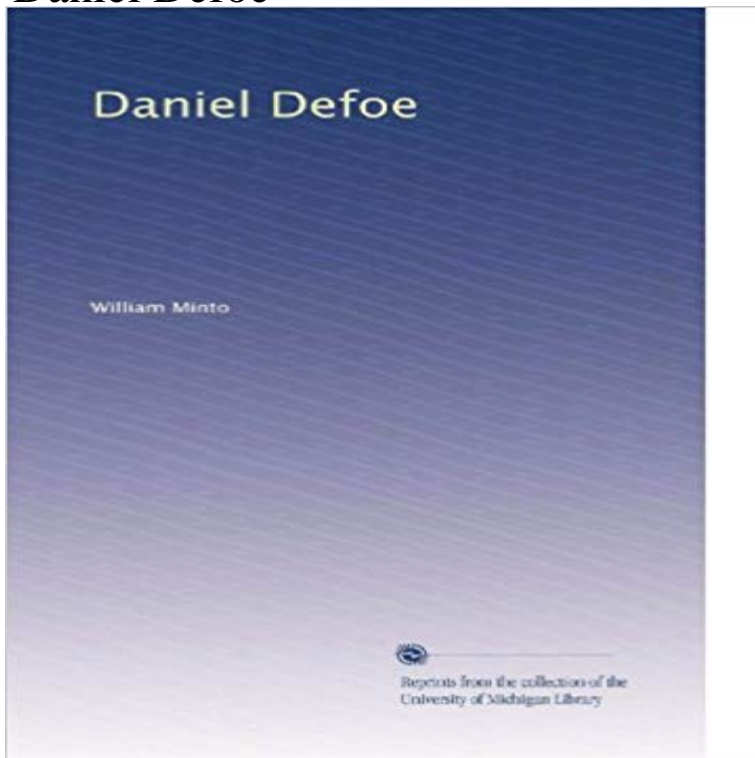


# Daniel Defoe
