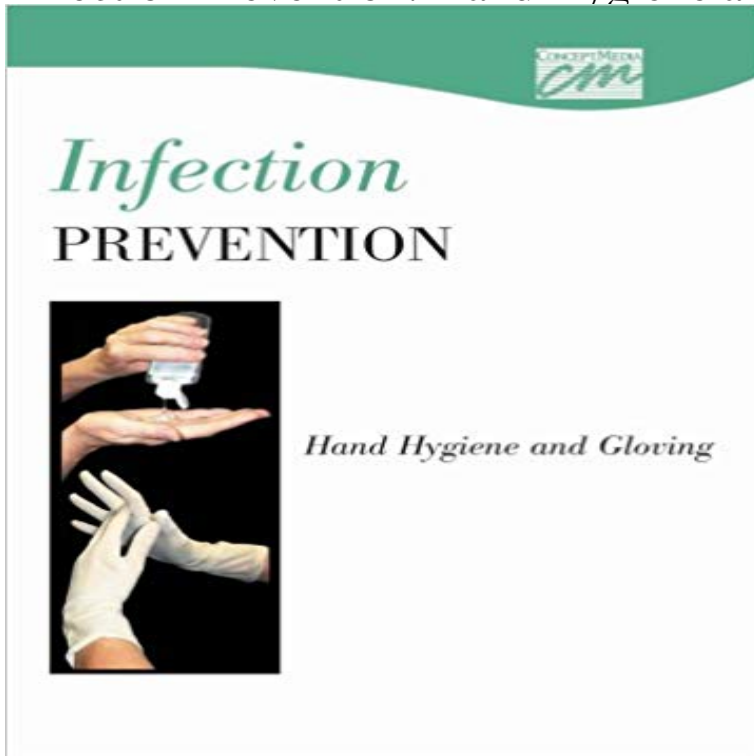


## Infection Prevention: Hand Hygiene and Gloving (CD)
