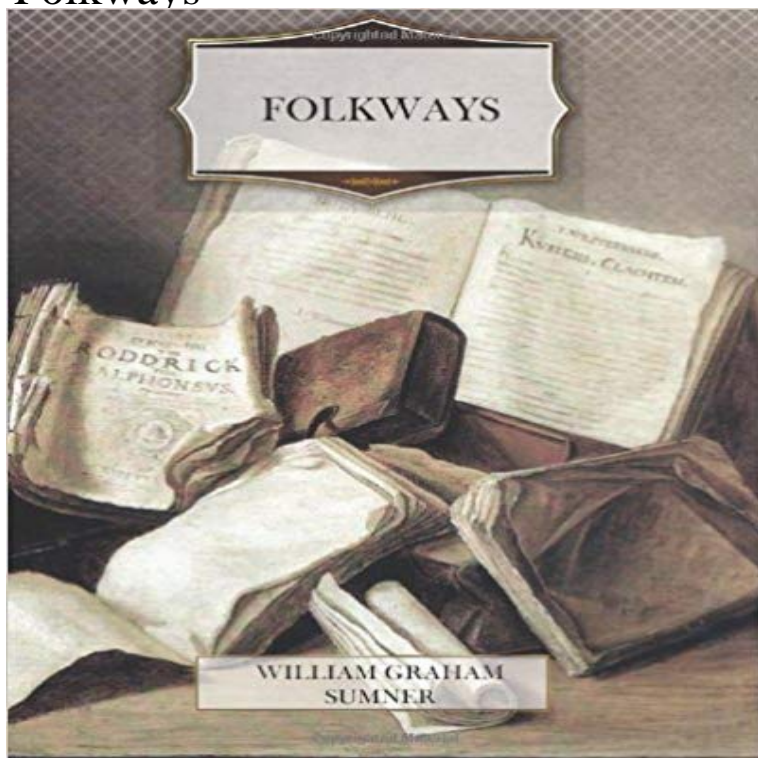


Folkways
