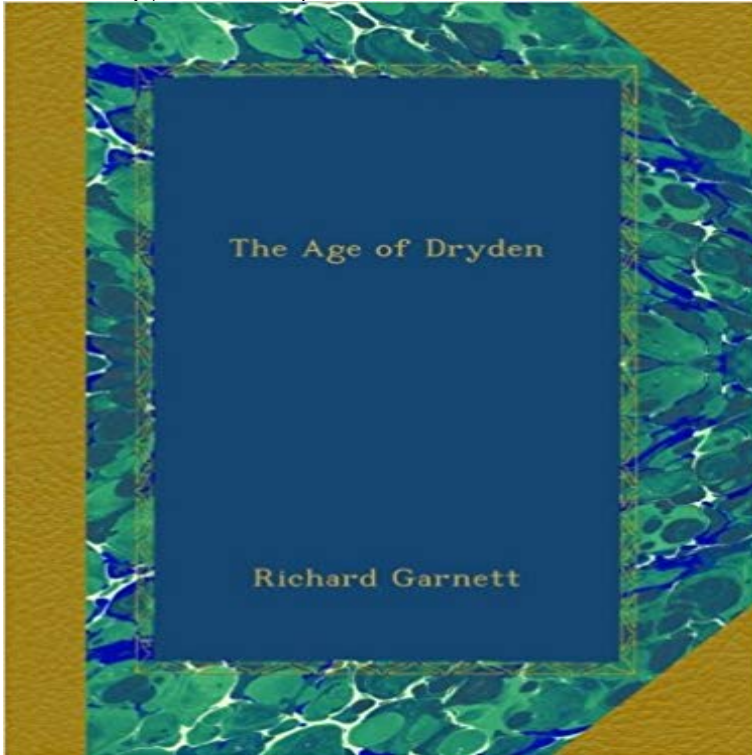


The Age of Dryden
